

**A.I.A.L.A. MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP RULES AND REGULATIONS**  
**Effective January 1, 2008**  
**According to the Board of Directors' minutes dated July 22,2007**

**M/F MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP**  
**And**  
**YOUNG M/F MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP**

1. Entry restricted to members who are up-to-date with the payment of their membership fee.
2. The points are awarded based upon the placings achieved in Specialty Shows and Meetings.
3. The member championship takes place in the course of the solar year from January 1 to December 31.
4. In the event of a tie, the trophy shall be awarded to the subject that, during the year, participated in fewer Specialty Shows and Meetings. In case of another tie, the trophy shall be awarded to the younger dog.
5. The subtotal of the points of the single subjects of Italian Breed will determine the awarding of the Breed Trophy.

**CRITERIA FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF POINTS IN THE**  
**M/F MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP**

- A. Counting of points is granted to the first 3 (three) placings entered in the classes competing for Best of Breed.
- B. The classes competing for Best of Breed are CHAMPION, OPEN, WORKING, and YOUNG.
- C. 1 point is earned for every M/F subject beaten entered in the classes competing for Best of Breed (see point B).
- D. The points may not be accumulated. Only the very highest score obtained in each single show is considered.

**CRITERIA FOR THE ASSIGNMENT OF POINTS IN THE**  
**YOUNG M/F MEMBER CHAMPIONSHIP**

- E. Counting of points is granted to the first 3 (three) placings entered in the Young class.
- F. The subject who has been placed first, if only in this class, earns 1(one) point when judged VERY GOOD and 2 (two) when judged EXCELLENT.
- G. 1 point is earned for every M/F subject beaten entered in the Young Class.
- H. . The points may not be accumulated. Only the very highest score obtained in each single show is considered.
- I. In order to be eligible for the title Young M/F Member Champion, a subject shall have received a minimum total score of 6 points.

**TITLES**

**MALE MEMBER CHAMPION:**

The subject that totalled the highest score. In the event of a tie, see item 4 of these rules and regulations.

**FEMALE MEMBER CHAMPION:**

The subject that totalled the highest score. In the event of a tie, see item 4 of these rules and regulations.

**YOUNG MALE MEMBER CHAMPION:**

The subject that totalled the highest score. In the event of a tie, see item 4 of these rules and regulations.

**YOUNG FEMALE MEMBER CHAMPION:**

The subject that totalled the highest score. In the case of a tie, see item 4 of these rules and regulations.

**TOP AFGHAN:**

The subject that totalled the higher score between the Male Member Champion and the Female Member Champion. In the event of a tie, see item 4 of these rules and regulations.
